## MEASURE SUCCESS


The recovery instruments measure the improvement of a consumer's mental health from multiple perspectives and dimensions. Agencies use the instruments to link outcomes to service effectiveness and system transformation. This process gives agencies a comprehensive picture and standardized method for examining effectiveness of services and outcomes. Data is entered into a web-based system, where it can be shared and discussed among staff and the consumer. The process is secure and HIPAA-compliant.



## DON'T GO IT ALONE

The Mental Health Center of Denver's success in a recovery and outcomes-focused system of services didn't happen overnight. Along the way, we learned a lot about the process of change and are bringing other like-minded agencies together to share lessons learned.

A detailed assessment is done for each agency that will enable our team to tailor trainings and consultation to fit your unique needs.



**Data informs daily clinical practice.** Using state-of-the-art technology, the reports are embedded into staff's workflow.
