Program Description:

The integrated care team provides comprehensive consultation and brief therapy to youth and their families within a pediatric primary care environment. Specific focuses of intervention address development, behavioral health, and mental health.

Title and Hours required:

Doctoral Student, 16-20 hours/wk, 12 month commitment, position begins July 2017.

Minimum Qualifications and # of openings:

1 opening for a doctoral level psychology student who has at least two years of graduate level clinical training. The trainee must have strong clinical interviewing and report writing skills. Course work in health psychology or previous health psychology placement preferred.

Student Supervisor's Credential Level:

PsyD/PhD

Duties of Placement and Miscellaneous Information:

Clinical Duties: The trainee will provide consultative services to pediatric patients in their medical home addressing behavioral health concerns to include: typical development, developmental delays, behavior concerns, anxiety, depression, ADHD, and family adjustment needs. Additionally, trainees will provide intervention to patients living with medical conditions such as chronic pain, obesity, or asthma that may be impacted by behavioral health. These services will occur in the form of either consultations or brief therapy.

Administrative Duties: Trainees will document treatment within the patient medical record in a timely manner not to exceed 48 hours within meeting with the patient or by end of day if urgent concerns were identified. The trainee will participate in 2 hours of supervision per week. At least one of those hours will occur via individual supervision with a licensed clinical psychologist.
