Program Description:

The PLAY program provides mental health consultation to child care centers in Denver. Using an embedded model, consultants are located at one child care center four days a week. Consultants provide support to child care providers, children, families and directors. Consultants work with providers to manage challenging behaviors and increase the social and emotional capacity of children and the center. The consultant brings a mental health lens to the center, educating staff and families on issues related to social and emotional development and mental health through reflection and trainings. Consultants also provide child and family therapy to identified children from their centers.

Title and Hours required:

Early Childhood Mental Health Consultant – intern. Hours can be negotiated based on needs of student. Some evening hours may be necessary to help with trainings.

Minimum Qualifications and # of openings:

MSW, LPC or LMFT one student in second year placement.

Student Supervisor's Credential Level:

LCSW

Duties of Placement and Miscellaneous Information:

Student would shadow one or more consultants at their child care center. Students would run social and emotional groups with children, observe identified children in their child care room in order to assist consultants with coaching and modeling managing challenging behaviors for providers, educate parents and providers on early childhood development (including social and emotional). Work with consultant to educate parents and providers about early childhood mental health. Assist consultants with parent and staff trainings.
